## **GOLF CART REGULATIONS**

## Planning on driving a Golf Cart within the Village? Ensure you know the rules before heading out!



Bylaw No. 06/2024 was recently passed the bylaw to allow Golf Carts within the Village.

- $\sqrt{}$  Must be operated in accordance with the rules of the road, and any municipal bylaw related to traffic. Federal and Provincial driving laws apply to golf carts.
- $\sqrt{10}$  Drivers must hold a minimum of a Class 7 driver's license.
- $\sqrt{}$  Owners must carry a minimum of \$200K in 3rd-party liability insurance and provide proof of insurance at the request of the RCMP or Bylaw Enforcement Officer.
- $\sqrt{}$  Cannot operate on any roadway with a posted speed over 50 km/h.
- $\sqrt{}$  Must display a slow-moving vehicle sign at rear of golf cart (as near to the center as possible).
- $\sqrt{}$  Must have a seat for each passenger.
- $\sqrt{}$  Must only be operated during daylight hours on roadways (half an hour after sunrise to half an hour before sunset).
- $\sqrt{}$  Cannot be capable of operating at a speed of more than 24 km/h on level ground.
- $\sqrt{10}$  Must not be operated on any provincial highway, other than to cross one.
- $\sqrt{1}$  Travel on the farthest right-hand portion of roadway.
- $\sqrt{}$  Must stay off pathways/walking path.

\*\*All offences and fines for not following the rules of the road under *The Traffic Safety Act* and regulations apply when operating a golf cart; same as any other vehicle operating on a public road. You can contact the RCMP for any violations you witness. \*\*
