BYLAW NO. 11/06

A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE USE OF BARBED OR RAZOR WIRE

The Council of the Village of Buena Vista, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. No person shall use barbed or razor wire for the purpose of erecting a fence or otherwise enclosing any building or parcel of land within the Municipality except as provided by Section 3 hereof.
- 2. No person shall use barbed or razor wire for the purpose of erecting a fence or enclosing any property within the business or residential areas of the Municipality.
- 3. Any person contemplating the use of barbed or razor wire in any part of the Municipality other than those mentioned in Section 2 hereof, shall first obtain the written approval of the Council of the Municipality.
- 4. The owner or person in possession of any property on which there is a barbed or razor wire fence or enclosure which has not been especially authorized by the Council, shall promptly remove all such barbed or razor wire upon receipt of a written request from the Council to do so, and in the event of neglect or refusal of such person to promptly comply with such request, the said barbed wire may be removed at the owner's expense, and the Municipality may recover the expense thereof with costs by action or in like manner as municipal taxes.
- 5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties imposed in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.
