BYLAW NO. 10/94

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BUENA VISTA FOR THE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF SNOWMOBILES

The Council of the Village of Buena Vista in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- Notwithstanding the provision contained in subsection (1) of Section 21 of The Snowmobile Act, R.S.S. 1978, it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile on any public highway in the corporate limits of the Village of Buena Vista only between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 12 midnight (local time).
- Police officers and police constables while engaged in the performance of their duties are permitted to operate a snowmobile 24 hours a day on any public highway in the corporate limits of the Village of Buena Vista.
- Any snowmobile found in contravention of The Snowmobile Act or this bylaw may be subject to seizure and impoundment for fourteen (14) days at the owner's expense.
- A person who contravenes this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
 - for the first offense to a fine of up to \$500.00 and in default of payment of the fine the person convicted may be committed to jail or to a public lock-up for any time determined by a Judge of the Provincial Court or Justice of the Peace not exceeding thirty (30) days, unless the penalty is sooner paid.
 - for a second or subsequent offence to a fine of up to \$1,000.00 and in default of payment of the fine the person convicted may be committed to jail or to a public lock-up for any time determined by a Judge of the Provincial Court or Justice of the Peace not exceeding thirty (30) days, unless the penalty is sooner paid.
- Sections 3.(g)(1) and (2) of Bylaw No. 4/85, are hereby repealed.
