BYLAW NO. 10/23

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BUENA VISTA TO DISPENSE WITH THE MAILING OF ASSESSMENT NOTICES

The Council of the Village of Buena Vista, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Bylaw may be cited as the "Assessment Notices" Bylaw.

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Bylaw is to dispense with the mailing of assessment notices, except as provided in this Bylaw.

3. DISPENSING WITH ASSESSMENT NOTICES

- (1) The assessor of the Village of Buena Vista is hereby authorized, except as provided in subsection (2), to dispense with the mailing of assessment notices where the assessed value with respect to any land or improvements:
 - a) Has not changed from the previous year's assessed value; or
 - b) Has decreased by not more than the lesser of:
 - i. One thousand dollars (\$1000) from the previous year's assessed value; and
 - ii. One percent (1%) of the previous year's assessed value.
- (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), assessment notices shall be mailed in any year in which assessable properties are revalued under the direction and supervision of the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency (SAMA).

4. TRANSITIONAL, REPEAL AND COMING INTO FORCE

- a) Bylaw No. 6/98 is hereby repealed.
- b) This Bylaw shall come into force on the day of adoption by the Village of Buena Vista Council.
