SEASONAL REMINDERS

WATER TURN OFF

Seasonal water was to be turned off by October 2. If you have not made arrangements to have this completed yet, please call the Village office ASAP to book an appointment. Water does not get turned off automatically. Any damage to lines or water meters as a result of freezing is the homeowner's responsibility.

GARBAGE & RECYCLING

Seasonal residents should ensure their bins are stored empty and back on their properties for the winter. Please note these bins are **not** to be used by full time residents through the winter months.

All bins are to be pulled up off the road as soon as possible after being emptied to ensure they don't impede with traffic or maintenance crews.

Also note, bi-weekly refuse collection returns in November. Refer to your collection calendar for details.

VILLAGE EMAILS NOT GETTING TO YOU?

Some residents have advised that the email notices we send to them are not always being received even though the emails are confirmed as "SENT" by our office email. This appears to be an email provider issue. If you are experiencing this issue, here are steps you can try alleviate it:

1. Go to Preferences – Mail – Spam
2. Check the box to "Enable Spam Filter"
3. Set your spam filter preferences with:
 - Select "Trusted Senders"
 - Enter "@buenavista.ca"
 - Click "ADD" (may have to add the domain name "@buenavista.ca")

This should allow you to receive all Buena Vista Office emails per your preference. However, if problems persist afterwards, you will need to contact your service provider for solutions.

Please note that as stated in the 'Homeowner Contact Detail & Email Authorization', failure to receive an email municipal notice does not release you from your responsibility to pay any charges specified on the notice or any penalties which may be incurred by late payment.
