SEASONAL WATER TURN OFF

Reminder that homeowners with seasonal water lines must make an appointment to disconnect their water no later than September 30th.

48-hours notice is required to book an appointment...which means September 26th is the last day you can book to ensure it's turned off by the deadline. Please note that availability of requested date or time is not guaranteed. Homeowners are not required to be present for a water turn off, however, it is strongly encouraged and recommended to ensure the water is off and nothing happens over the winter season.
