

As per Bylaw No. 4/23 Standard Watering Restrictions in effect May 1<sup>st</sup>—October 31<sup>st</sup>.

On days watering is permitted, it is only allowed between 6:00am-9:00am & 6:00pm-9:00pm. No watering of lawns/gardens is permitted on 'Waterless Wednesdays'.
