BACK TO SCHOOL

WATER SYSTEM MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of our water system is scheduled for September 11 - 13. Watch for details but please plan to conserve water and expect a Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory to be issued from Sept 13 through the weekend.

OUTDOOR WATER USAGE CHANGES

Please find attached our new "Standard Watering Restrictions" information page. This new outdoor watering schedule came into effect on August 8, 2023, and will remain perpetually in effect between May 1 and October 31st each year unless we need to enact a full water use ban. Please be water wise! Know and follow your allowed watering dates and conserve water wherever you can.

SUMMER RESIDENTS – WATER DISCONNECTIONS

Here are a few reminders regarding summer water services:

1. It is your responsibility to contact the office with minimum 48 hours notice to arrange your water turn off. This year only we have extended the final day for seasonal turn offs to October 2.
2. Maintenance of your water meter is your responsibility. Please ensure you have disconnected it prior to blowing out any of your private lines to prevent damage to the meter.
3. Ensure the water meter is either completely drained or not allowed to freeze over the winter months. Any damage to the water meter from not winterizing it properly will delay turn on next spring. As well, all costs to repair the meter will be your responsibility.
4. If you remove your water meter from the village, you will have to supply us with your final water meter reading via phone or email.

PATH SHACKS

**** Attention:** *To anyone who has received previous notice of an unauthorized shack on Crown Land adjacent to the walking path. ***

All structures must be removed by September 21st. Any structures remaining after that date will be removed by the Village at the owner's expense. The Village will not be responsible for any damages resulting from the move.

DID YOU KNOW....?

Leaving recycling or garbage bins rolled out not only impedes roadway work but can cause dangerous sight line issues. It also costs us money! Every bin tip, even if the bin is empty, is tallied by Loraas and charged to the Village. Please only put bins out as needed. If you have room to wait until the next pick up, please do so to prevent unnecessary tipping fees. Pull bins back once emptied. Summer residents, please be sure to store your bins far back from the roadway for the winter season. Full time residents – note that you are not allowed to use summer residents' bins as your own extra disposal.
