BYLAW NO 4/16

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BUENA VISTA TO REGULATE DRAINAGE

THAT the Council of the village of Buena Vista, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this bylaw is to regulate surface drainage on public and private land.

2. RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PROPERTY OWNER

- 2.1 The owner of a premises shall not permit roof drainage, foundation drainage or sump pump drainage from a building or property on the premises to be discharged:
 - (a) directly onto a pervious ground surface within one metre of the building;
 - (b) within one metre of an adjacent lot;
 - (c) to a location where the water has the potential to adversely impact:
 - (i) the stability of a slope,
 - (ii) a Village roadway; or
 - (iii) a portion of the ground surface where there exists a risk of instability; or
 - (d) to a location, or in such a manner, that the discharge causes or has the potential to cause nuisance, hazard or damage during the winter months.
- 2.2 Any owner of a premises shall contact the Village office before discharging onto Village property.

3. PENALTY

- 3.1 Any person who violates any provision of this Bylaw shall be deemed guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a penalty of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
- 3.2 Any subsequent offence shall be liable to a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) each contravention.

4. COMING INTO FORCE

4.1 This Bylaw shall come into effect on it final reading.
