BYLAW 9/14 RECYCLING COLLECTION BYLAW

The Council of the Village of Buena Vista, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Purpose

1. The purpose of this Bylaw is to regulate the collection and disposal of recycling by the Village

Definition

2.

- a) "**approved container**" means a container that meets the requirements of and has been approved for use in the Village of Buena Vista
- b) "**automated collection**" means the collection of recycling by a system of mechanical lifting and tipping of containers into specially designed vehicles
- c) "**roll-out cart**" means a container on wheels approximately 0.4 cubic metres in volume and designed for automated collection
- d) "**recyclable material**" means any material collected for the purpose of recycling or reuse
- e) "**recycling container**" means an approved container for collecting recyclable material
- f) "residence" means a dwelling of any type as defined in the Zoning Bylaw
- g) **"residential recycling container**" means an approved container for use at each residence
- h) "Village" means the Village of Buena Vista
- i) **"Waste collector**" means any appointed waste contractor, performing waste collection for the Village

General

3. Collection

Recycling will be collected by the recycling contractor twice a month. Except for Christmas Day.

4. Waste Containers Recycling containers will be supplied by the contractor and no other container shall be used for recycling collection in the Village.

- 5. An owner or occupant of a property within the Village shall ensure that there is unobstructed access to recycling container.
- 6. No owner or occupant of a property that is assigned a roll-out cart shall place recycling in any container except that container assigned to their property.
- 7. No person other than the owner, occupant or operator of a property to which a waste container is assigned shall disturb or disrupt the contents of a waste container.
- 8. No person shall deposit special or unacceptable recycling into any container.
- 9. No person shall cause or permit any loss of, or damage to, a recycling container.
- 10. Where automated recycling collection from roll-out carts is in effect:
 - a) each residence shall be provided with one roll-out cart for the sole use of the owner or occupant of the residence; and
 - b) roll-out carts shall not be removed from the residence by the owner or occupant, or used for any purpose other than as permitted in this Bylaw.
- 11. Unless otherwise directed, roll-out carts must be:
 - a) set out at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day and placed:
 - (i) at least 1.3 metres from any obstructions such as parked vehicles
 - (ii) so that they will not be likely to overturn;
 - b) removed from the street as soon as possible, and in any event within 24 hours
 - (c) stored on the property of the residence when not placed out for collection
- 12. No person shall dispose of recyclable material anywhere other than in accordance with the terms of this Bylaw.
- 13. A person who has disposed of recyclable material in a manner contrary to the provisions of this Bylaw shall remove the recyclable material or cause the recyclable material to be removed upon being directed to do so
- 14. Unless otherwise specified, the owner or occupant of a residence shall be responsible for complying with the terms of this Bylaw.

- 15. No person shall:
 - a) overfill a recycling container so that recyclable material may fall to the ground
 - b) pile recyclable material above the top of a recycling container
 - c) place recyclable material on the ground at or near the base of a recycling container or anywhere at a recycling depot other than in a recycling receptacle
 - d) place any recyclable material in a recycling container not designated for the type of recyclable material or as specified
 - e) place garbage in the container

Offences

- 16. Every person commits an offence who:
 - a) allows excessive recyclable material of any kind to accumulate on or in any land or building other than as permitted in this Bylaw; places or disposes of recyclable material other than as permitted in this Bylaw
 - b) causes or permits any loss of or damage to a recycling container
 - c) leaves a recycling container on a public right-of-way for more than 24 hours; and
 - d) fails to maintain a recycling container in a sanitary state

No person shall:

- a) fail to comply with an order made under this Bylaw;
- b) obstruct or hinder a municipal inspector acting under this Bylaw; or
- c) fail to comply with any other provision of this Bylaw.

Penalty

- 17. Any person who contravenes a section of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine:
 - a) for the first offence, of \$100.00;
 - b) for a second offence, of \$200.00; and
 - c) for a third or subsequent offence, of not less than \$200.00 and not more than \$10,000.00.

Effective Date

18. This Bylaw shall come into force on the third and final reading by the Village of Buena Vista Council.
